It's that time of year again – the BCIT Career Awareness Workshop date has been set!

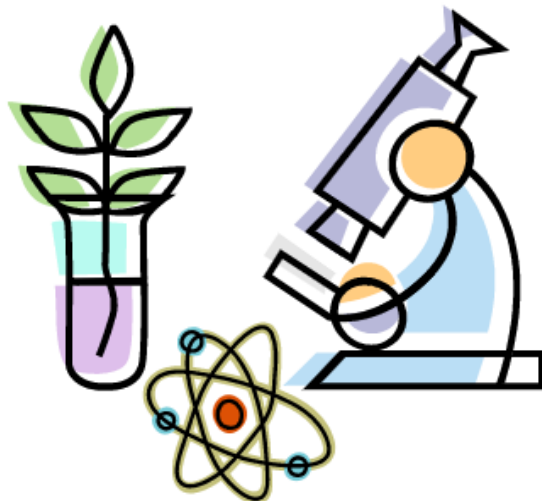
